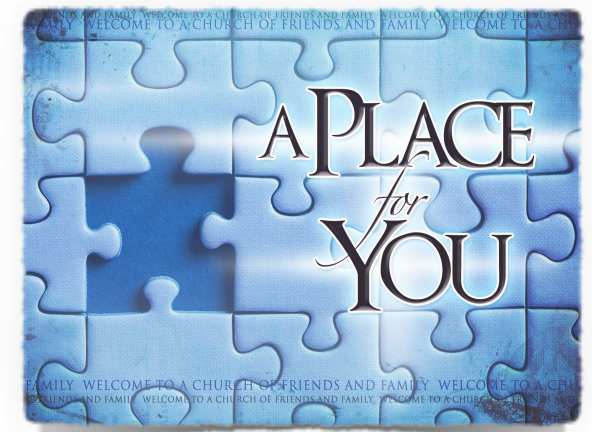

Sermon Title: A New Command - John 13:31-35

Introduction: In this series on loving our neighbors, we have already focused on...

- (1) The 5 Love your Neighbor Laws Leviticus 19
- (2) Who is your neighbor? (Good Samaritan - Luke 10) Anyone with a need.
- (3) What if your neighbor is your enemy? (Matthew 5)

Today, we want to answer **2 questions:** (1) What does love look like inside the church? and (2) What impact will that have on those outside the church?

- II. Jesus identifies Judas as His betrayer (v. 18-30)
