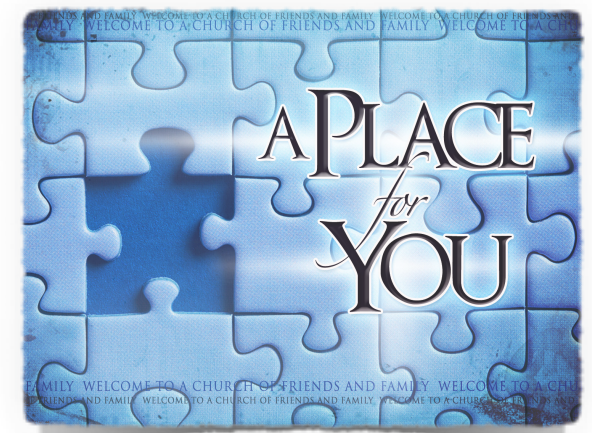

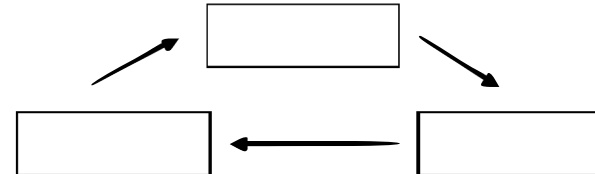

## **Sermon Title: A Ministry of Reconciliation - 2 Corinthians 5:14-21**

**Introduction:** Sometimes, churches are guilty of losing sight of our p\_\_\_\_\_!

Today, we will focus on what it means to love those outside the church enough to warn them about their broken relationship with God, and how that relationship can be reconciled.

### **I. The Path of Love (v. 14-15)**



2 Implications: (v. 16-17)

(See also I Corinthians 6:9-11 and Jonah 4:1-2.)

Point: We who have been r\_\_\_\_\_ to God need to start seeing people, not for who they are in the f\_\_\_\_\_, but for who they *can be* in C\_\_\_\_\_!

### **II. Our Purpose on Earth (v. 18-19): Ministry of R\_\_\_\_\_**
