

Sermon Title: Love Your Enemy - Matthew 5:43-48

Introduction: We have already learned that we should love our neighbor, even if they are not of the same religion or ethnicity, but what do we do if the other person is a downright enemy?

Context: In Matthew 5, Jesus is explaining to the Jews how to interpret the Law. They needed to learn how to live by the spirit of the Law.

The Saying: "L your neighbor and h your enemy." (v. 43-44)
