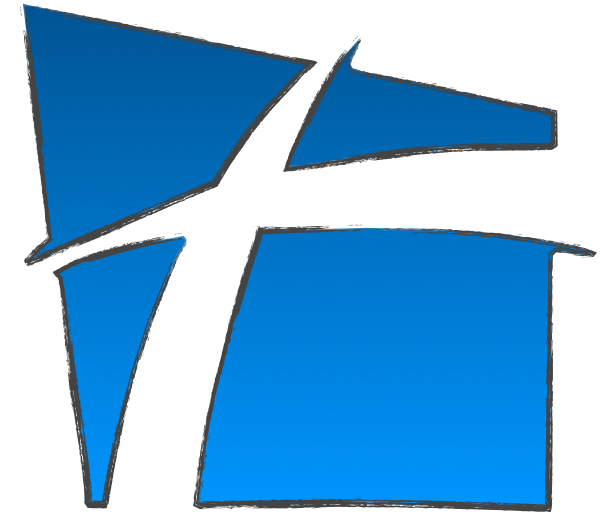

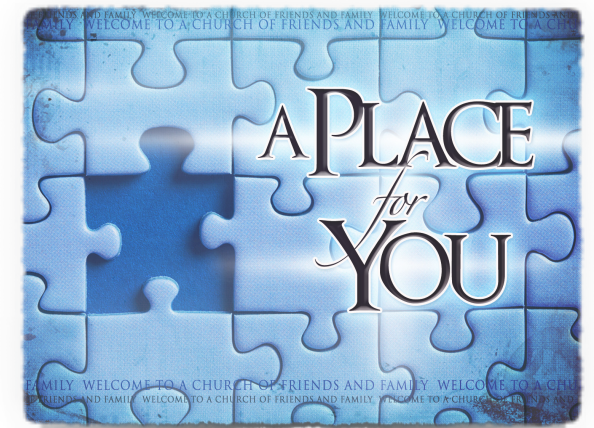

## The Wrong Way Prophet- Jonah 1:1-16

Background: Jonah was a successful prophet who had previously brought  
\_\_\_\_\_ to the kingdom of Israel. (2 Kings 14:23-25)

**Main point: God loves us and our neighbors too much to allow our \_\_\_\_\_  
to be callous.**

In this passage, we see God show love through a \_\_\_\_\_ and through a
